THIS VINEYARD IS COOLER THAN OTHER BLOCKS ON THE ESTATE, WITH STEEP SLOPES AND THIN SOILS, AND WITH EXCELLENT DRAINAGE DUE TO THE PREDOMINANCE OF BALLAST IN THE UPPER LAYERS.

This elegant yet powerful Tannat has aromas of red fruits such as cherries and strawberries, black plums, tobacco, and black chocolate, with a spicy background. It is juicy and fresh in the palate, and has a full-body with a lingering finish, perfectly balanced with a touch of oak.
